Artists and craftsmen are invited to participate in this juried market of original fine arts and crafts. The two day event is visited by an average of 15,000 visitors a year.

Deadlines

Friday, July 21 - application forms due.

Late applications will be juried individually on a space available basis.

Tuesday, August 1 - jurors decision mailed to artists.

Friday, September 15 - Space rental payment must be received.

Monday, October 2 - Cancellation after this date results in forfeiture of space rental fee.

Application and Fees

Each artist must submit:

- ◆ A completed application form
- ◆ Three slides/prints
- ◆ \$20 nonrefundable application fee
- ◆ SASE (self-addressed stamped envelope)

Slides or prints are acceptable. Photos should be representative of the artist's work and should include samples of the high end and low end of the artist's price range. The third photo should show the assembled exhibit. Photos should be numbered and clearly marked with the artist's name.

Artists who wish to exhibit **more than one medium** must submit a separate set of photos for each. (Maximum of two).

Artists working together as a team to produce one body of work will be judged together. Artists producing work individually but who **wish to share a booth** must **each** submit an application with photos and the \$20 nonrefundable application fee. The work will be judged individually. Please indicate the artist sharing with you on your application.

Accepted artists must submit a space rental fee of \$80 per 10' X 10' space.

Eligibility

Nature's Gallery Artist Market is open to artists working in any medium, including but not limited to: Pottery, Fiber Arts, Jewelry, Woodcarving, Photography, Pastels, Oil, Watercolor, Acrylic, Ink, Pencil and Mixed Media.

The Artist Market is for original work only. Each work must be an original of the artist, both in design and finished product. Sale of prints made from original artwork is permitted, 50% of display must be original work. Examples of unacceptable material include, but are not limited to, works produced by patterns, kits and machine reproductions.

Market Operation

Artists must be present during all scheduled market hours and may not rely on sales agents. Each exhibit must be open and ready for the public during all scheduled open hours. **Artists may not begin breaking down their booths prior to 4:30 P.M., Sunday, October 29.**

Artists are encouraged to offer a range of prices with the holiday gift shopper in mind. **All sales and the collection of taxes are the responsibility of the artist.**

Demonstrations

Demonstrations are encouraged and are a good way to draw shoppers to your display. Every effort will be made to provide extra space for demonstrations. Please submit a description of your demonstration and your space requirements with your application.

Space Requirements

A maximum of 50 artists will be selected to display and market their works. Artists are required to provide attractive tents or canopies to cover their area and are responsible for tables, chairs, shelves etc. needed to make the booth attractive and accessible. **Tarps or make shift coverings will not be accepted for display, but exhibits not in closable tents must be covered by tarps at night.**

The market exhibits must be uncluttered, self-contained, freestanding and capable of withstanding weather and crowds.

Regular exhibit space will measure 10 X 10 ft. No guy lines or other booth supports may extend outside the booth rental space.

Power and water are available. In order to use these utilities, you will need a heavy duty outdoor extension cord, and for water - a hose with a 'Y' joint adapter.

Liability

Park gates will be locked at night, and security will be provided. However, we suggest that artists carry their own insurance. The NATURE'S GALLERY, the Friends of St. Andrews State Park, St. Andrews State Park, their officers, employees, directors, members, or volunteers, or anyone connected with the exhibition will not be responsible for loss, damage or injury, however caused. Your entry into this exhibition constitutes agreement with these terms and conditions.
